

## Notes on Testing PhotoEntry, PEX & DiCentra

To assist clubs with familiarising themselves with the competition software and procedures, a test copy of the 2019-20 SLF Season has been setup in *PhotoEntry* and a corresponding set of *Test SLF Season DiCentra Rules* is available to download from the SLF website.

### When Testing in PhotoEntry

- Use the link on the SLF website (Competitions page>Competition Info & Resources) and log in using the *PhotoEntry ID* for your club.
- From the Main Menu, select the *Competition Group Test SLF Competition Season* **NOT** the actual competition season!
- You will see a test version of every competition this season plus an extra one called *Test Uploading Images*. The competition(s) that you are hosting will have a running man symbol against them.

### What to Test

1. It's suggested that you firstly familiarise yourself with uploading a panel of 9 images to the *Test Uploading Images* competition in the *Test SLF Competition Season* in *PhotoEntry*. Use the *How to Submit Images...* instructions on the SLF website to assist you (Competitions page>Competition Info & Resources).
2. Our hosts should then familiarise themselves with what they will need to do when hosting their competition(s). Use the *Host Club Procedures & Building & Running...* instructions on the SLF website to assist you (Competitions page>Host Club Info & Resources), noting that:
  - To test this, you must be running *DiCentra* version 4.12.289 or later and must have a *PEX* licence installed on all copies of DiCentra being used for the competition(s) (one *PEX* licence does all). *PEX* licences are available from Wilbur Imaging for £8 at: <http://www.wilburimaging.com/machform/view.php?id=31808>.
  - The test *DiCentra* Rules to import and use are in the *Test SLF Season DiCentra Competition Rules* download on the SLF website (Competitions page>Testing Resources) **NOT** the ones in the Host Club Info & Resources section.
  - You can prepare your test competition for entries (using *PEX* and *DiCentra*) and upload your own club's entry of 9 images (using *PhotoEntry*). This will allow you to close the competition, download the images & perform all the remaining steps in the instructions. Your club will be the only one represented in the competition but it will allow you to perform the necessary steps.
