HOLROYD TROPHY

Presented by Mr. R.O. Wooton of Putney CC (1947)

To be awarded annually to the society winning the final of the Federation Inter-Club Monochrome Print Competition.

VICTIS-HONOS TROPHY

Presented by Sutton CC (1965)

To be awarded annually to the society who are runners-up in the final of the Federation Inter-Club Monochrome Print Competition.

OWEN TROPHY

Presented by Mr. H.S. Hurkett of Mitcham CC (1952)

To be awarded annually to the best print receiving a Certificate of Merit during the Federation Inter-Club Monochrome Print Competition.

COLOUR CHALLENGE TROPHY

Presented anonymously (1963)

To be awarded annually to the society winning the Federation Inter-Club Colour Slide Competition. This trophy was last awarded in 2011.

QUARTZ TROPHY

Purchased by the Federation with the help of Streatham CC (1975)

To be awarded annually to the society who are the runners-up in the Federation Inter-Club Colour Slide Competition. This trophy was last awarded in 2011.

CLERK MAXWELL TROPHY

Purchased by the Federation (1964)

To be awarded annually to the best colour slide in the Federation Inter-Club Colour Slide Competition. This trophy was last awarded in 2011.

ALEX FALK TROPHY

Presented by Mr. Alex Falk of Mr Cad, Windmill Road, Croydon (1976)

To be awarded annually to the society winning the final of the Federation Inter-Club Colour Print Competition.

FRANK TAYLOR TROPHY

Purchased by the Federation (2010)

This trophy replaces the South Suburban Trophy, Presented by the South Suburban PS (1985)

To be awarded annually to the society who are the runners-up in the final of the Federation Inter-Club Colour Print Competition.

KEITH JOHNSON PHOTOGRAPHIC COLOUR TROPHY (KJP COLOUR TROPHY)

Presented by Keith Johnson Photographic Limited (1987)

To be awarded annually to the best print receiving a Certificate of Merit during the Federation Inter-Club Colour Print Competition.

VIC SMITH TROPHY

Presented by Vic Smith of Selsdon CC (2006)

To be awarded annually to the society winning the final of the Federation Inter-Club Projected Digital Image Competition.

QUANTAGRAPHIC TROPHY

Presented by Vic Smith of Selsdon CC (2008)

To be awarded to the society who are the runners-up in the final of the Federation Inter-Club Projected Digital Image Competition.

EDWIN APPLETON ROSE BOWL

Presented by Sutton CC (2008)

To be awarded annually to the best projected digital image receiving a Certificate of Merit during the Federation Inter-Club Projected Digital Image Competition.

MONOCHROME CUP

Presented by Mr. P.S. Shen (1956)

To be awarded annually to the society winning the final of the Federation Inter-Club Monochrome Print Plate Competition.

(Note: This trophy was re-assigned in 2010 from the best monochrome slide competition which was discontinued owing to lack of support in 1979. Monochromatic slides are now accepted as "colour slides" in Federation competitions)

PENFOLD PLATE

Presented by Jeff Penfold ARPS of Selsdon CC (2010)

To be awarded annually to the society winning the final of the Federation Inter-Club Colour Print Plate Competition.

RICHARD FRANKFURT PLATE

Presented by Richard Frankfurt Photographic (2010)

To be awarded annually to the society winning the final of the Federation Inter-Club Projected Digital Image Plate Competition.

RETINA CUP

Presented by Mr. E.C. King (1952)

To be awarded annually to the best print in the Open Competition for Monochrome Prints. The judge may also award up to three Certificates of Merit.

COLOUR CUP

Presented by Mr. E.G. Johnson ARPS of Crystal Palace PC (1956)

To be awarded annually to the best slide entered in the Open Slide Competition. This trophy was last awarded in 2011.

PUNCH BOWL

Presented by Mr. E.L. Appleton FRPS of Sutton CC (1977)

To be awarded annually for the best print in the Open Colour Print Competition. The judge may also award up to three Certificates of Merit.

JACK'S JUG TROPHY

Presented by Jack Bates FRPS of Selsdon CC (2005)

To be awarded annually for the best image in the Open Projected Digital Image Competition. The judge may also award up to three Certificates of Merit.

AUDIO-VISUAL CHALLENGE TROPHY

Purchased by the Federation (1985)

To be awarded to the winning presentation entered in the Federation Audio-Visual Competition.

The competition may be held annually or biennially at the committee's discretion, and is for sequences of projected images accompanied by sound, projected to a single screen.

The judge will award the trophy to the winning sequence, and up to three Certificates of Merit.

At the discretion of the organisers, there may be, in addition, a competition for club sequences
